Submit a typewritten, I I pt Times New Roman, single-spaced, one page only essay, addressing the following based on your experience or research:

 If you currently or have in the past belonged to an organized labor union, describe to the committee how the labor movement and union membership has benefitted you and/or your family personally, professionally, socially, and/or globally.

OR

- If you have never belonged to an organized labor union, discuss the positive impact the labor movement and membership in organized labor unions has on workers, families, communities, and society.
- REFERENCE LETTER Please include one letter of reference (do not submit more than one letter). Possible authors include a teacher, counselor, advisor, supervisor, co-worker, or employer; someone who knows of your goals, potential, work ethic, and motivation.

NOTE: In order to give fair weight to all essays, the scholarship committee will not consider any portion of an essay exceeding the allotted length.
